Guidance notes for Race Recorders

for Club Dinghy, Classic Dayboat (CDB) and Chichester Scow racing

This role would be the perfect first steps towards becoming an Assistant Race Officer (ARO) or even a Race Officer (RO).

It involves writing down all the details of the competitors, namely their sail numbers, the boat class and the helms' names.

When they cross the finish line, sail numbers will be recorded and for the handicap classes, the 'elapsed time' of each competitor – taken from one of the chronometers operated by the race officer.

These results then need to be transferred to the results sheet, two copies of this taken using the photocopier in the North Room (Key in the RO's bag), one copy given back to the RO, one copy posted on the noticeboard in the entrance hall and one copy posted to the office outside the office door.
